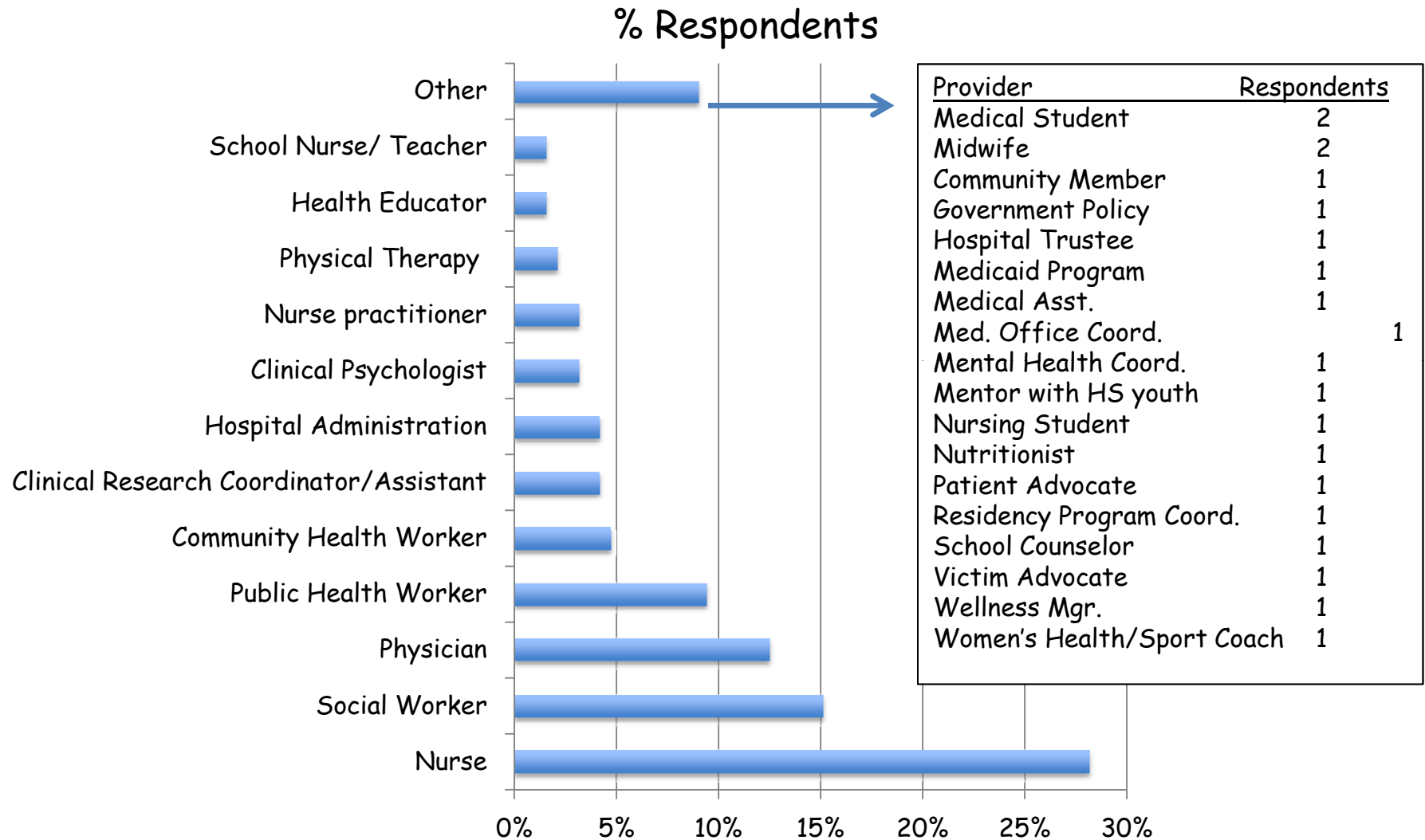


TYPES OF PROVIDERS RESPONDING



NOTES:

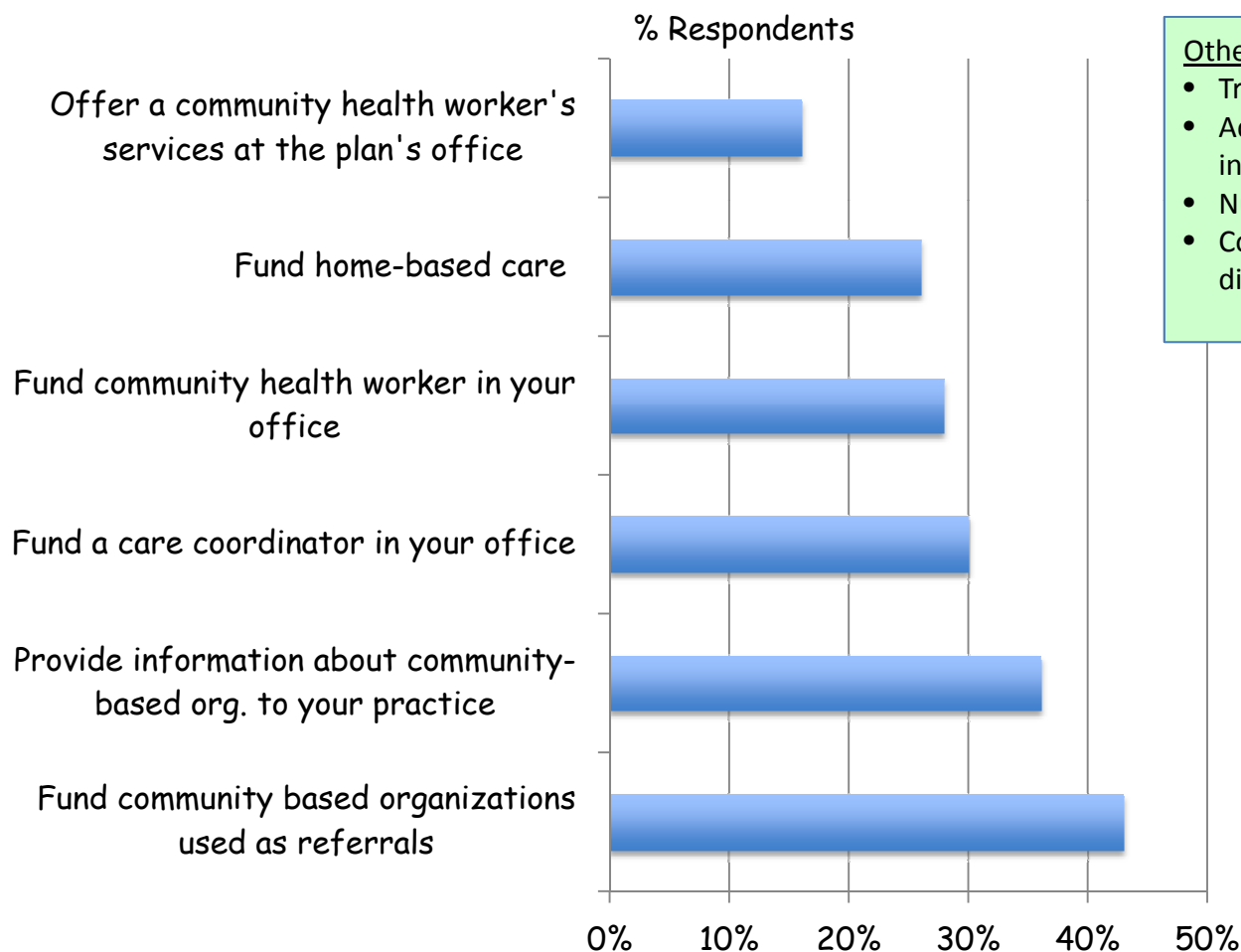
- Where a respondent checked two types of provider, the one counted was that which appeared more closely related to their current position
- Some respondents filled in more specific positions whereas others may not; where entered it was counted
- Some surveys may not have been completed

What are the biggest socioeconomic gaps that impede your vulnerable population from accessing health care?

Income	4.18	156	2
Unemployment	3.82	151	7
Transportation	3.74	152	6
Education	3.28	150	8
Housing	3.00	145	13
Language	2.76	145	13
Food Insecurity	2.59	145	13

*Respondents were asked to rate the severity of each stressor from 1 to 5 with 5 being the most severe impediment to health care access. To calculate the average weight, the responses were weighted based on the number reported.
